**MONGOOSE PROHIBITION (BARBUDA)**

1. This Act may be cited as the Mongoose Prohibition (Barbuda) Act. **Short title.**

2. It shall not be lawful for any person to introduce into the Island of Barbuda any mongoose; and any person who introduces or attempts to introduce or is concerned in introducing into the said Island of Barbuda any mongoose, or who knowingly harbours or keeps any mongoose in the said Island, shall be liable on conviction before a Magistrate to be imprisoned for a period not exceeding six months, or to pay a penalty not exceeding five thousand dollars. **Importation of Mongoose prohibited.**

3. Any mongoose brought to or found in the said Island of Barbuda may be seized and destroyed by any person. **Power to seize and destroy mongoose.**

If shall be lawful for the Secretary of the Barbuda Council or for any Justice of the Peace, or police officer, or any person acting in aid or under the direction of the Secretary, Justice of the Peace, or police officer to enter during the day-time any place or premises, and to search for, seize and destroy any mongoose found therein.
